

V. Logout

The PSRS application has three privileges levels and they are: OAT PSRS Administrator or Level A user, Program PSRS Administrator or Level B user, and Reviewer or Level C user. Level A users have access to all available functions of PSRS. Level B users are given administrative privileges if they are assigned to a specific program, and all non-assigned programs can only be reviewed. Level C users are given reviewing privileges.

I. Main

The Main Screen



The Main Screen is the first screen the user sees after logging into PSRS system.

Inside the Main Screen, the links and menus displayed are grouped into four different sections.

In the Program's Progress or the "Programs" section, the user will be able to view and update the current report depending on their access level.

In the QSR Charts Section, the user will be able to view, print, and upload quarterly reports. The QSR Charts Section is dependent on a user's access level.

The last section is the Administrative Options or the Admin Section, the users will be able to manage their accounts (password change, update user information, etc.), add user and edit existing users, and manage the meeting date functions. The Admin Section is dependent on a user's access level.

For Level A

All features and functions are viewable, useable, and displayed.

For Level B

Level B users have access to everything like Level A users except for:

The Program's Progress Section is only viewed and updateable by the users' assigned program. This section will be read only when the user is not assigned to the programs. Level B users will not have access to Programs Maintenance thus the "edit/add" link besides the By Programs select list will not be displayed. Also, QSR Cover Page and Summary are read only.

The Generate PMC Reports on Local Computer Section and Upload PMC Reports & Presentations Section are accessible for level A users only.

The Administrative Options Section will not have the Meeting Dates link appear because the Level B and C users are restricted from this function.

For Level C

Level C users have access to everything like Level B users except for:


The Program's Progress will be read only because Level C users do not have permission to update the reports.

The QSR Cover Page Screen can be accessed by clicking on the "Programs" top menu button. It can also be accessed by clicking on "QSR Cover Page" link on the left menu bar when the user is in the "Programs" section.

Inside the QSR Cover Page section there are two buttons displayed: "Edit Page" and "Print Preview". To edit the QSR Cover Page, click on the "Edit Page" button, which will take the user to the QSR Cover Page Edit Screen. To preview a printable version of the QSR Cover Page, click on the "Print Preview" button.

Only Level A users have access to the QSR Cover Page Edit Screen, thus the "Edit Page" button will not be seen by Level B and Level C users.






PMC QSR Complete Set Screen






